Our school division is informing parents and guardians that two school community members have been diagnosed with Coronavirus (COVID-19). This person was on school premises on October 30, 2020 and did have direct exposure with other members of our community.

The Ahkwesàhsne Mohawk School will remain closed and online learning will continue. We are working closely with the MCA Dept. of Health to identify anyone who had close contact with the person(s) to determine if they might have been exposed to the virus that causes COVID-19.

If you or your child are identified as having been potentially exposed, the Ahkwesàhsne Mohawk Board of Education will be contacting you. You will then be asked to please stay home and monitor for symptoms of cough, shortness of breath, or a temperature higher than 100.0°F or 38°C, and practice social distancing for 14 days from your last contact.

We ask that our staff and families remain vigilant with social distancing, mask wearing, and frequent hand washing. We encourage you to limit social contacts to those within your immediate family household. Please be safe, we are all in this together.
